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GABRIEL GARCIA MARQUEZ



Read the biography of Gabriel Garcia Marquez and answer the comprehension questions using the passage for reference.

Gabriel García Márquez (1927 - 2014) was born in Aracataca, Colombia, a small town that would later inspire much of his literary work. Raised by his maternal grandparents, García Márquez grew up listening to their stories, which were often filled with folklore, superstitions, and tales of the supernatural. These early experiences deeply influenced his writing and laid the foundation for his unique storytelling style known as "magical realism."

After studying law and journalism, García Márquez began his career as a journalist, writing for newspapers in Colombia and later in Europe and Mexico. His journalistic work was characterized by his sharp observations of society and politics, which also informed his fiction and provided a rich backdrop for his stories.
