Selena Quintanilla (April 16, 1971 – March 31, 1995) was an American singer, songwriter, and performer who became one of the most beloved stars of Latin music. She was born in Lake Jackson, Texas, and grew up singing in her family's band. Her father, Abraham, recognized her talent early and encouraged her to perform with her brother and sister.

As a teenager, Selena became known for her powerful voice and sultry performance. She sang Tejano music, a style that blends Mexican and American sounds. At first, people were surprised to see a young girl leading a band, but Selena's talent quickly won them over. She released many popular songs and became known as the Queen of Tejano Music."

Selena's albums, such as *Amor Prohibido* and *Entre a Mi Mundo*, sold millions of copies. In 1994, she won a Grammy Award for her album *Selena Live!* in the category of Best Mexican-American Album. This made history as one of the first times a female Tejano artist received such an honor. She was loved not only for her music but also for her kindness, style, and ability to connect with fans.

Sadly, Selena's life ended too soon in 1995, when she was only 23 years old. Even though her life was short, her music and spirit continue to inspire people around the world. Selena's story shows the power of following your dreams and sharing your talents with others.
