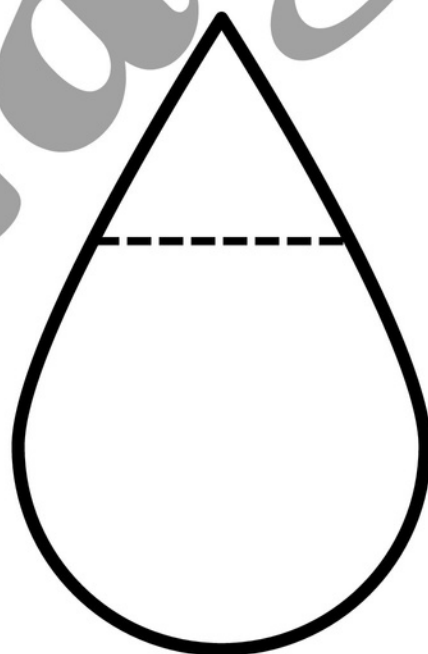
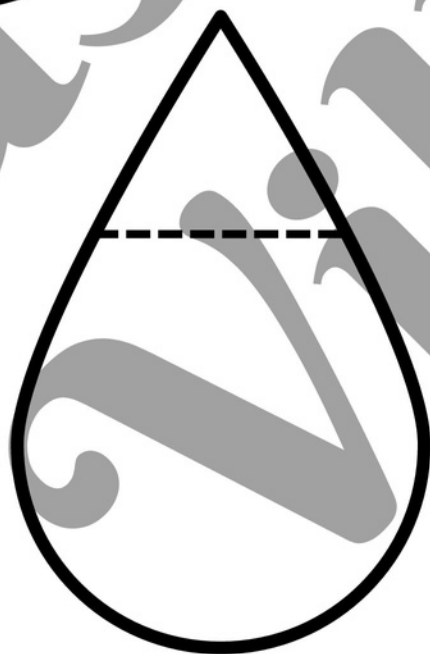
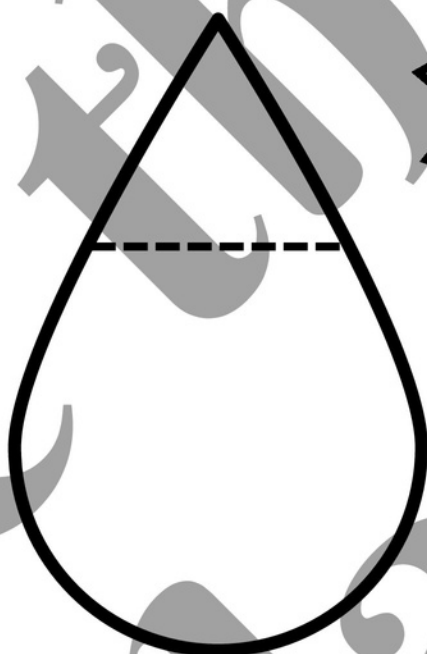
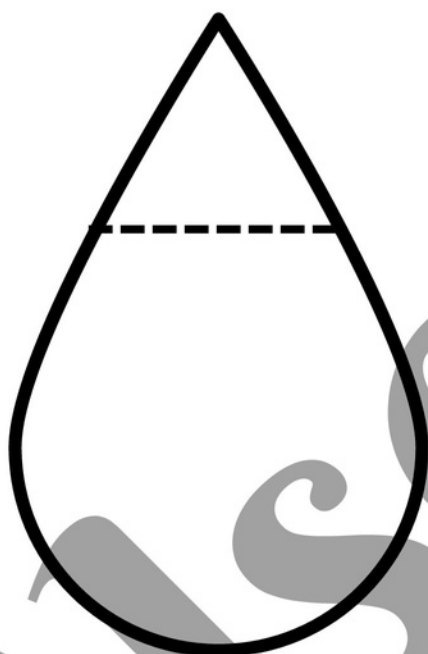




Color your raindrops and flowers. Then, cut out each raindrop and fold on the dotted line. Use glue to paste the top half of the rain drop above each flower so that the bottom half covers most of the petals. Let dry, then lift to reveal each colorful flower!

April Showers Bring May Flowers Craft – Teacher Directions

Materials Needed:

- Printed templates (one per student)
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Optional: Cotton balls, blue tissue paper, construction paper, bulletin board materials

Step-by-Step Instructions:

Introduce the Activity:

Discuss the phrase "April Showers Bring May Flowers" and how rain helps plants grow. Read a related book or poem about spring and weather changes.

Cut & Decorate the Pieces:

Have students color the raindrops, flowers, and cloud before cutting them out. If using the pre-written phrase, let them cut out and glue it inside the cloud or write it on their own.

Assemble the Raindrop Flaps:

Guide students to fold each raindrop along the dotted line. Students glue only the top of each raindrop above a flower so that the bottom half lifts up to reveal the flowers underneath.

Finishing Touches:

Optional: Let students add extra decorations like cotton ball clouds, blue tissue paper for rain, or glitter for sparkle.

Once dry, encourage them to lift each raindrop flap to reveal the flowers!

Optional: Encourage students to write something they've learned or a goal for spring under their raindrops, symbolizing how they will "grow" like flowers!

Bulletin Board Display Ideas:

Spring Garden Scene:

Arrange all the student projects together on a bulletin board to create a large field of flowers. Attach the projects so others can lift the raindrops to see the hidden flowers. Add cotton balls for clouds, blue streamers for rain, or a sun peeking through! Add a title banner: "April Showers Bring May Flowers!"
