SONIA SOTOMAYOR

Read the biography of Sonia Sotomayor and answer the comprehension questions using the passage for reference.



Sonia Sotomayor (born 1954) was born in New York City to a Puerto Rican family. Growing up in the Bronx, Sonia faced many challenges, including poverty and the early loss of her father. Her mother, Celina, worked long hours as a nurse to support the family and instilled in Sonia the importance of education and hard work.

Despite the obstacles, Sonia excelled in school. She earned a scholarship to Princeton University, where she graduated summa cum laude.
