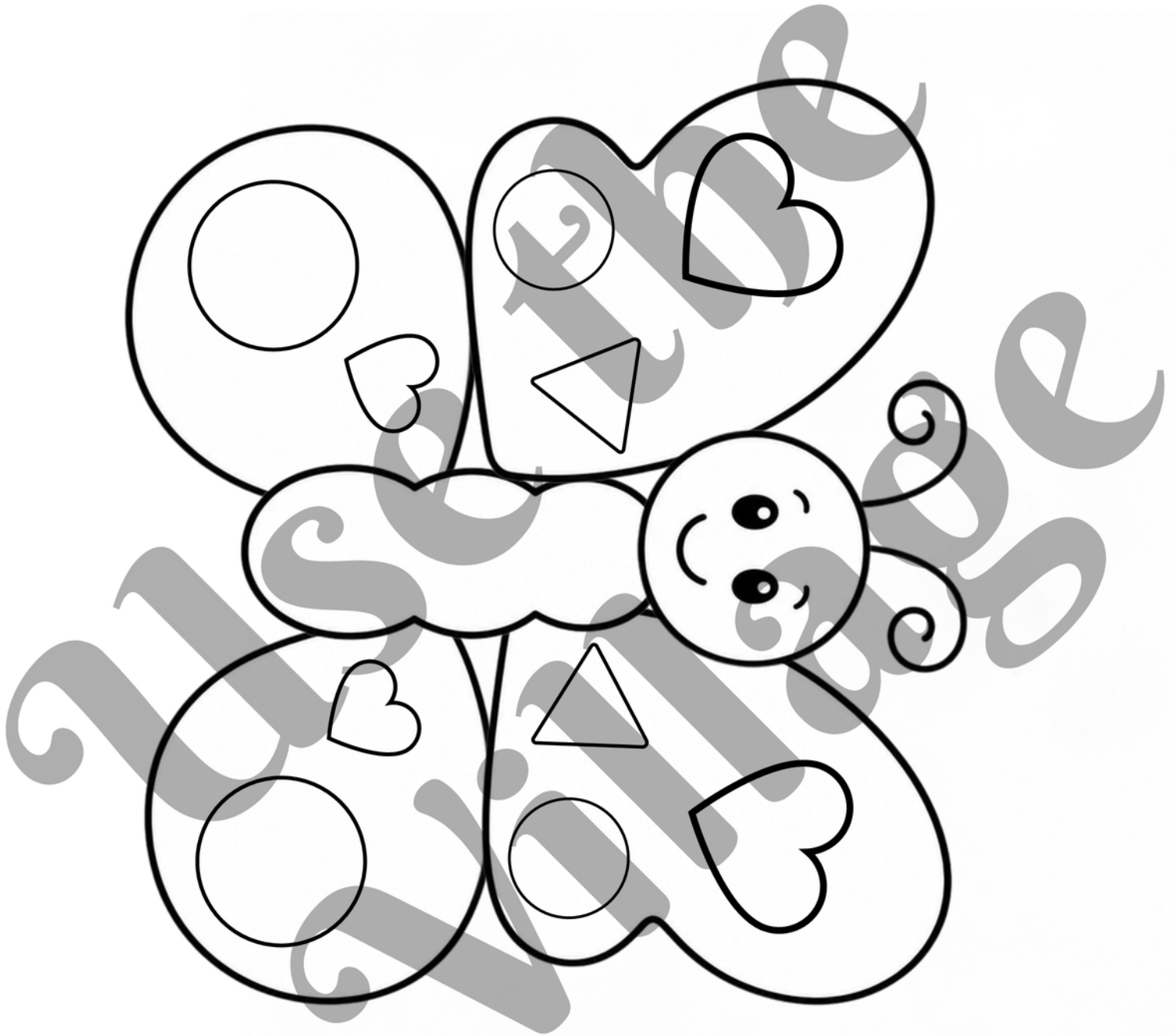
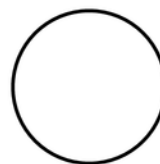
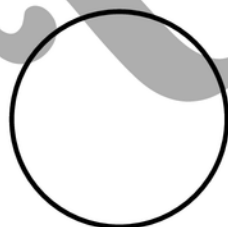
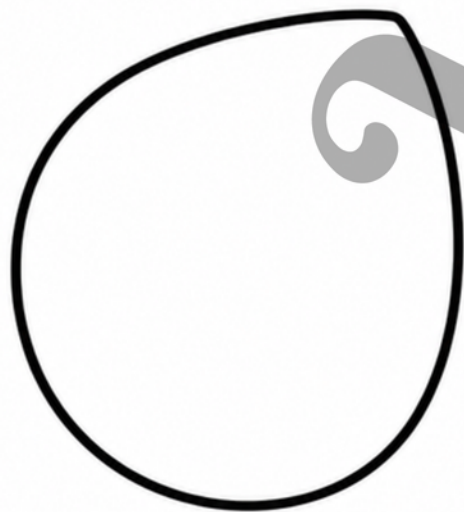
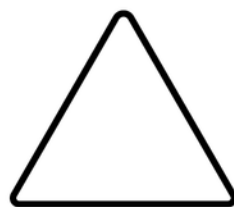
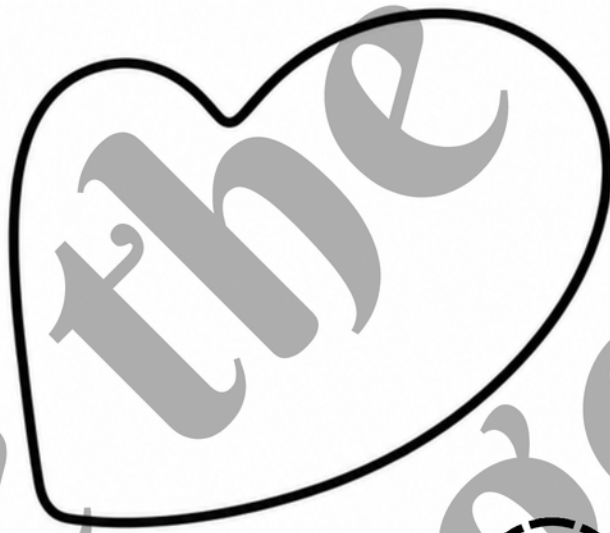
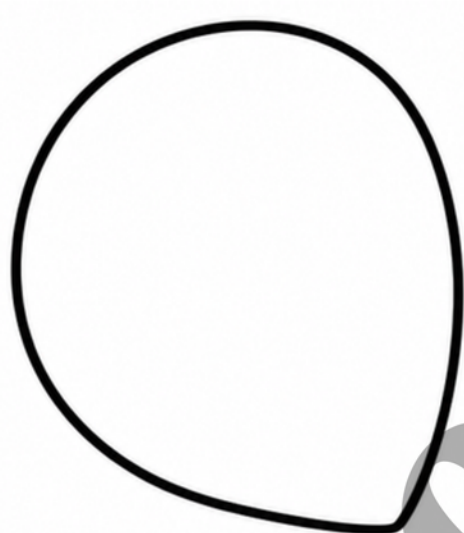


Example of Assembled Butterfly

Butterfly Cut & Paste Craft – Teacher Directions

1. Print

Print the butterfly pieces and the garden background for each student. Use the color version or the black-and-white version.

2. Cut

Have students cut out the butterfly parts. You may want to pre-cut pieces for younger students.

3. Decorate

Let students color the butterfly pieces and add their own shapes or designs to the wings before gluing.

4. Glue

Glue the wings to the back of the butterfly body. Glue the head to the top of the body and attach the antennae above the head.

5. Assemble

Glue the finished butterfly onto the garden background.

6. Optional

Let students color the background if using the black-and-white version. Add extra details such as other insects, clouds, or trees!
