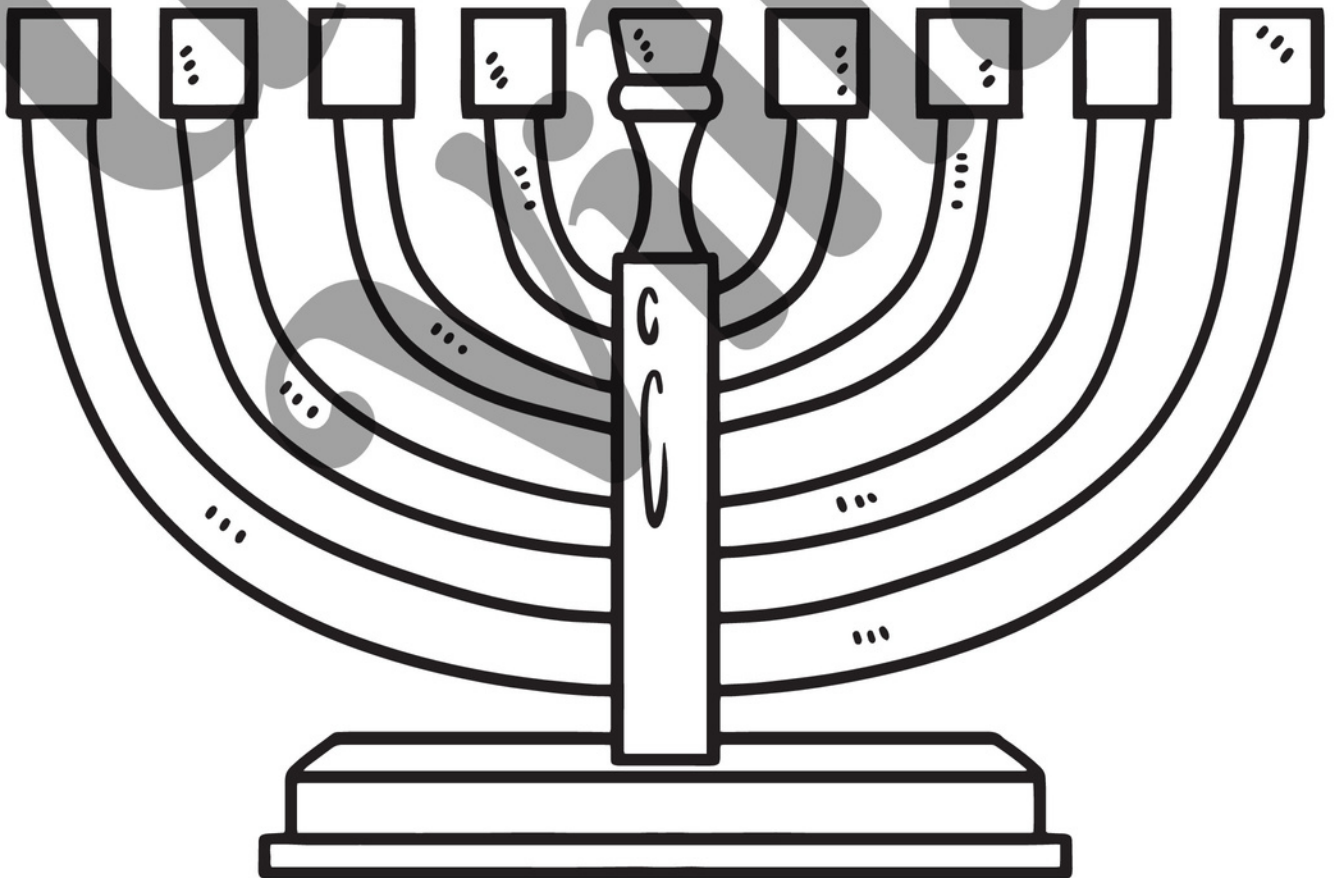

## **What is Hanukkah?**

Hanukkah is a special holiday where Jewish people celebrate a miracle. A tiny bit of oil that was supposed to last one day kept the menorah, a special lamp, burning for eight days. To remember this, families light candles on a menorah, eat yummy foods like latkes and donuts, and play a spinning game with a dreidel!

## **What is a menorah?**

The menorah is a special candle holder used during Hanukkah. It has nine branches: one for each night of Hanukkah (eight in total) and one extra in the middle called the shamash, or "helper" candle. Each night, one more candle is lit using the shamash until all the candles are glowing on the last night. The menorah reminds us of the miracle when oil that was supposed to last one day burned for eight days!
